RE/PSHE
Our R.E. lessons will see us learning about the beliefs and values of different religions [Islam, Hinduism and Sikhism]

English

Maths
In Maths, our topics will be Number, Place Value, Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division. We shall also become more fluent in our 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s times tables and corresponding division facts. We shall also be working on achieving our Passport targets.

Art /D&T
As **artists** we will make/use a simple sewn sketch book and use a range of drawing media
As **designers**, we will be designing and making our own Roman Chariots during our mini topic. .

MFL
In French we will be introduced to greetings, feelings, numbers 1-20, days of the week and months of the year.

Geography
In Geography, we will be using our knowledge of maps to create our own sketch maps and plans using compass points. We will also be identifying human and physical features of the Northern and Southern hemispheres and the Arctic and Antarctic Circles.

Health and Wellbeing
We will be learning about positive relationships and the importance of keeping healthy through diet, exercise and emotional wellbeing.

Physical Education
Our P.E .lessons will see us developing our skills in Dance, Athletics and Invasion Games. We shall also be learning more about Health and Fitness.

History
Through our main topic we will be developing our historical enquiry skills including asking relevant research questions, using appropriate historical vocabulary and comparing and contrasting our lives to children living in past times.
We shall also be studying The Romans during our mini topic.

Music
In Music, we will be singing songs and accompanying them with different instruments. We will also learn how to play musical notes on a glockenspiel.

Science
